## *Jessica's School of Dance Dress Code*

Proper dress is important for a successful dance class. All required items may be purchased on your own or through the studio. Jewelry beyond small stud earrings should never be worn in ANY dance class and dancers will be asked to remove it. **THIS INCLUDES EVEN OUR YOUNGEST DANCERS.** Dress code will be enforced in all classes and you will be notified if your dancer is not properly dressed for class.

**All dancers must have their hair securely fastened away from their face and neck. A headband is not sufficient on its own to qualify as having hair pulled back. Buns are encouraged on all ballet dancers.**

### *Creative movement:*

Any style leotard is acceptable at this level. Pink tights and pink ballet slippers are encouraged, as they will also be used for the recital.

DO NOT purchase the satin ballet slippers that are for sale at many local stores. Only leather shoes with elastic will be allowed in class.

### *Ballet :*

Black leotard – any style -small accents of rhinestones or pink are acceptable **SKIRTS ARE NOT.** No colored leotards. Pink tights and pink ballet slippers are required on **ALL** ballet dancers. Skirts are no longer acceptable in ballet class at **ANY** level with the exception of special days. Dancers may choose to wear black ballet shorts (this is not the same as athletic shorts and they will not be allowed in class ) if they wish at any level. Please see photos in the lobby for clarification.

DO NOT purchase the satin ballet slippers that are for sale at many local stores. Only leather shoes with elastic will be allowed in class.

### *Jazz and Hip Hop:*

Black leotard – any style- capri length black jazz pants, black jazz shoes. Form fitting SOLID colored tops may be worn over leotards. NO pajama pants or baggy clothing. Full length pants are not allowed in class.

### *Tap:*

Leotard –any color-, black tap shoes, pink tights, skirts or shorts are optional. No baggy clothing please.
